

Student Scholarships AY '15-16

1. Inner-city Scholarship Fund

Inner-City Scholarship Fund (Inner-City) through the generosity of its donors and in partnership with the Archdiocese of New York offers and administers a variety of scholarship and financial assistance programs for thousands of students attending Catholic elementary and high school in the archdiocese. Awards will range from \$500 to \$3100 per student. There are currently 11 students who receive this award totaling \$19,000.

- Criteria:**
- Student must be currently enrolled in an elementary school within the Archdiocese of New York, and/or must have a minimum GPA of 80;
 - Families have to meet the income eligibility guidelines listed below;
 - Students must be recommended by their school principal.

2. Children's Scholarship Fund

CSF is committed to strengthening American K-8 education by educating parents and the public about state and local policies that give all children access to a good education, regardless of their family's income level or where they live. The highest scholarship amount for 2016-2017 will be \$3,100. There are currently 44 students who receive this award totaling \$102,265.

- Criteria:**
- Student must be current UPK children or new incoming children in grades K-7th;
 - The family has to meet the income eligibility guidelines listed below

3. Teddy Forstmann Scholarship Fund

At Children's Scholarship Fund (CSF), founded by the late Ted Forstmann and John Walton in 1998, is a national charity funded entirely with private dollars. CSF established the Teddy Forstmann Scholarship Program in 2012 to provide scholarships to low-income families so their children can attend the K-8 schools that will help them reach their full potential. The highest scholarship amount for 2016-2017 will be \$3,100. There are currently 17 students who receive this award totaling \$40,850.

- Criteria:**
- Ensure at least 90% attendance of the student;
 - The family has to meet the income eligibility guidelines listed below

4. Father Nobiletti Scholarship Fund

This is a 50% tuition scholarship awarded to children of Transfiguration employees. There are currently 14 students who receive this award totaling \$47,400. The school is not reimbursed for this amount.

5. The HSA Scholarship Fund

The parent association has awarded \$12,000 to be divided equally among the three campuses for emergency scholarship assistance to families who experience financial hardship during the year.
